Criteria:

Open to all financial members of SEDC.  
Member must obtain a log sheet from the club.

*Member to record all dressage performances where placed in Top 4 at any official or associate EFA or HRCVA event.*

Points to be allocated thus:

**1st place = 6pts, 2nd place = 5pts, 3rd place = 4pts, 4th place = 3pts, 5th place = 2pts, 6th place = 1pt**

*\*Log sheet must be stamped by the club conducting the event to verify the results – just like getting your TTT log stamped!\**

Members can email a running total of their points to the club for publication in the newsletter each month so you check on how you're doing.

To be eligible for the award, the Performance Log must be submitted no later than January 31<sup>st</sup> each year. The award will be presented at the annual February Dressage Event.

Members are eligible for the award on more than one horse, however separate log sheets need to be maintained for each combination.

The combination with the highest points accrued over the course of the year (1st Feb – 31st Jan) will be declared the
